Fun Fact: Kate was in choir and musical theatre since she was little, and music continues to be a big part of her life. She believes music is essential to a loving and fulfilling life!

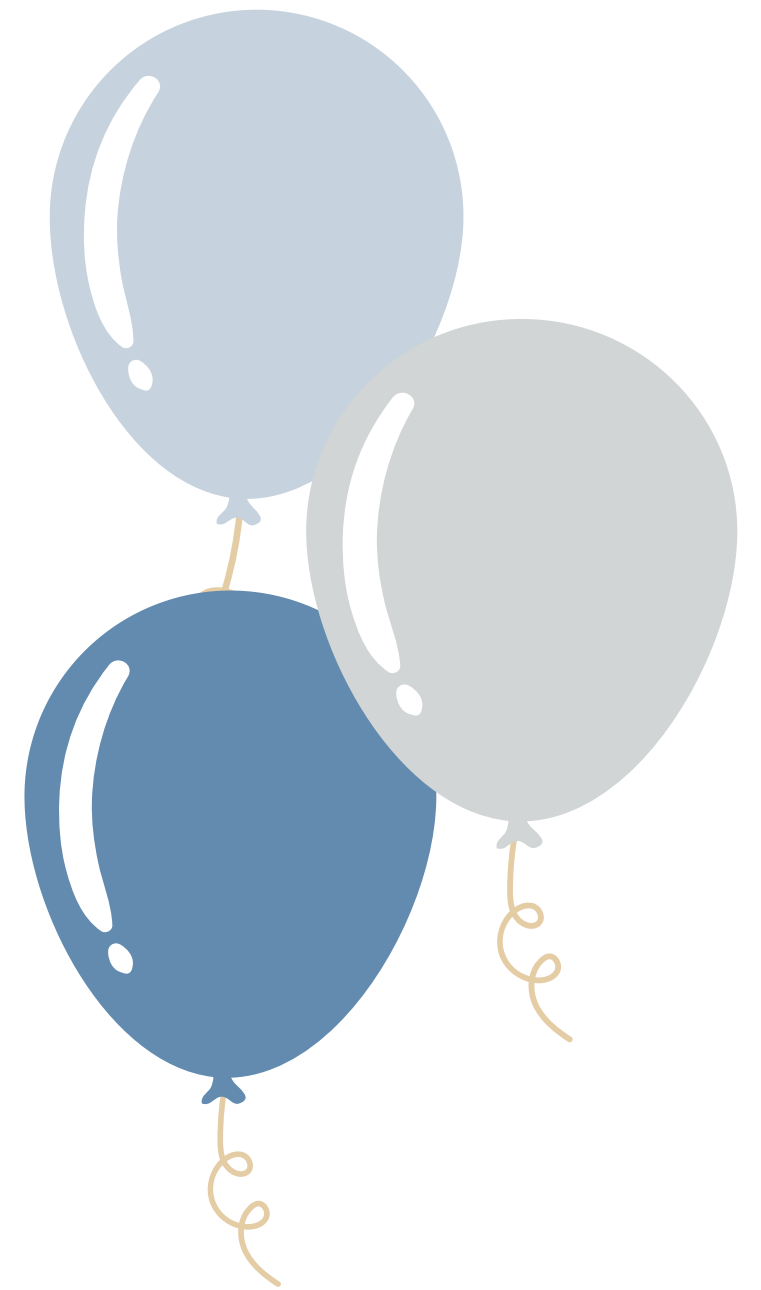

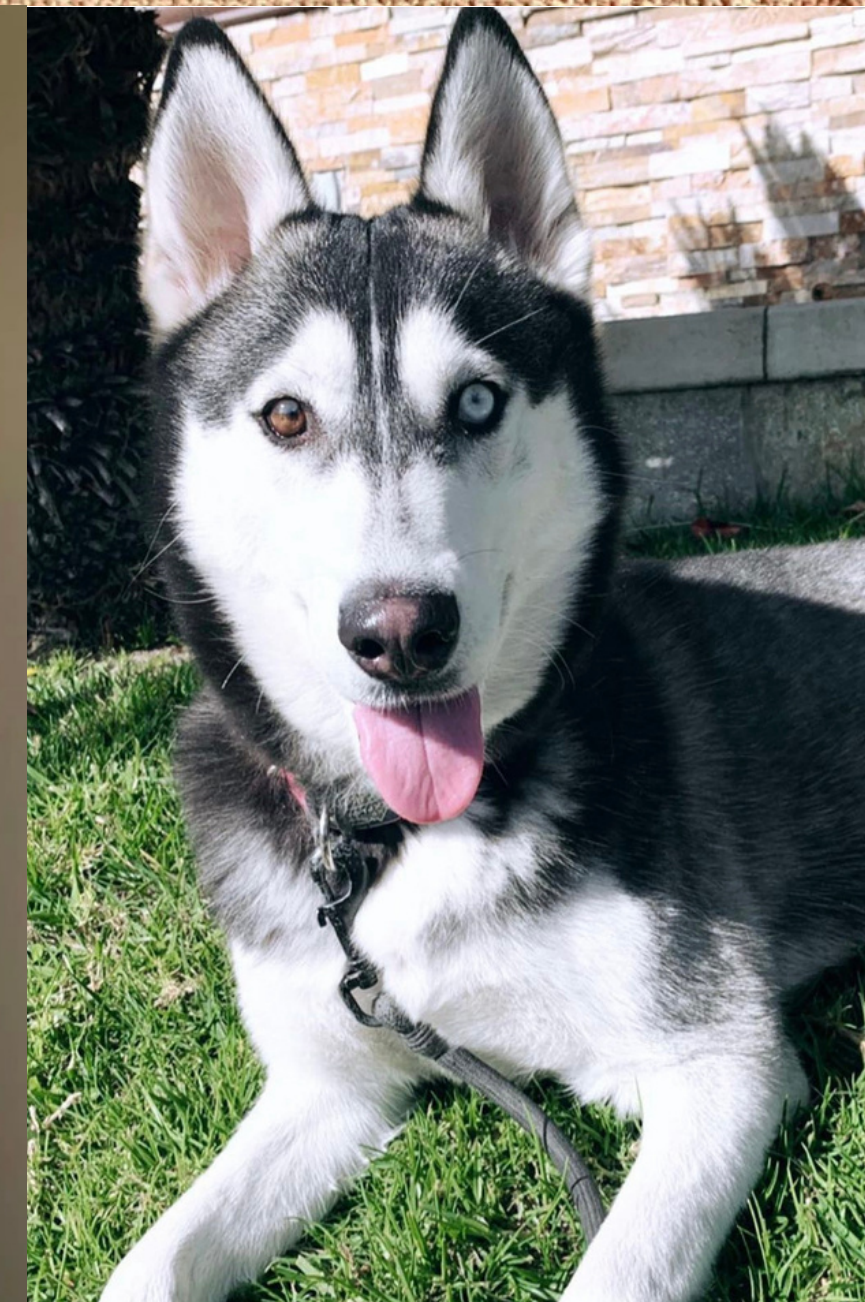


PCAS OF THE MONTH
